A Teacher applicant is expected to:

- work five days a week to setup camp activities prior to student's arrival.
- oversee approximately 20 campers.
- design and modify innovative lesson plans that relate to camp themes.
- direct and communicate with their Camp Counselors and Counselors-in-Training (CITs).
- connect with different facets of Rowan University to ensure camp needs are met.
- maintain a positive relationship with the parents of campers.
- assist periodically with running the camp's After-Care opportunity.
- be an essential component and leader in pre-camp training.
- report all camp activities to the appropriate supervisors and directors.
- do other tasks to help with the successful implementation of the Camp EduAdventures experience!
