Much “Moore” Than a Book Club

No Ashes in the Fire, a memoir by Darnell Moore

A close read and discussion of a powerful text, this book club is an opportunity to challenge ourselves with a deeper understanding of equity. During the 8-part face-to-face series, participants will read the author’s deeply personal account of growing up in Camden, New Jersey as a Black, gay male during the 1980’s and 90’s. Through personal recollection and societal critique, Moore’s journey from Camden to Mullica Hill Friends

School to Seton Hall University urges the reader to (re)consider, (re)examine, and reconcile their own understandings of gender, class, and race. Further, this book club will ask participants to engage in dialogue, collaborative activities, and shared meaning-making in the hope of learning more about themselves and one another.


