In order to apply for NJ certification, students must pursue a certification in another area, such as Elementary Education, Early Childhood Education, Subject Matter Education, Health and Physical Education, Art or Music Education.

ESL is currently one of the *critical shortage teaching areas* in NJ and in most areas of the US, so there are currently numerous job opportunities available to candidates with this certification
