Field Experiences:

Please note that most of the courses have a field requirement. The hours for each course are indicated next to the course title (front page). These are outside of class hours and may be arranged at times of mutual agreement between the student and the cooperating teacher and, often, are shared with courses from other programs (e.g., LLSC). You will be asked to complete and submit a **Field Placement Request Form**, via TK20, for each field-based class. The electronic Forms are processed by the Office of Field Experiences (OFE) to insure that all students have a placement. For those employed full-time in a school environment, many of these experiences can be completed in your own building.

Signature Assignments:

Each course has one or more signature assignments. These assignments are directly related to the professional standards set by the State of New Jersey and by our national organization, Council for Exceptional Children.

Praxis Requirements:

*Passing Score = 151 (*This score was determined by using the minimum passing score for the three closest states that currently require the Praxis II for certification (DE = 151; MD = 151; PA = 151).

For students who do not earn a score of 151, the following GPA/Praxis II score formula will be used. This formula is derived from that which is used by the New Jersey State Department of Education, as noted in the New Jersey Teacher Certification Information System document (March, 2005) – with adjustments made based on our departmental commitment to only recommending certification for candidates who meet high standards.
