

Rose Glassberg Scholarship for Student Teaching Application Instructions

Award Description: The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize the achievements of an undergraduate English and Education major who will be student teaching during the upcoming academic year (2017-2018). The criteria for selection involve a 3.0 GPA in English and pre-professional courses. This \$1,000 award is given to a senior during the student teaching semester.

To apply: In a word document, provide the information listed below and answer the short essay question. In a 2012 Interview with the *Gloucester County Times*, Rose Glassberg¹ offered the following advice to new teachers:

“Learn your subject sufficiently to be passionate about it, and try to communicate that passion to your students. Try to teach them to think, to learn the skills they will need to really understand what you are trying to do in the classroom. Don’t lie to your students, and don’t embarrass them. Keep your temper. Keep a sense of perspective. Have a sense of humor and be able to laugh at yourself.”
